  - b. What are some things that can hinder God's dreams for you? For instance, what can stop you from discovering God's dreams for you, or from making them become reality?

3. Name and describe the three phases God uses to release us into his dreams for us.
  - a. Why is a "safe place to fail" such a great gift?
  
  - b. What is the difference between playing it safe and being willing to fail, and how does this relate to the question: "what are you doing that would fail unless God is in it?"
  
4. In addition to God's work in their lives, what did Kit and Bob (p. 139-145) have in common that aided their release into God's dreams for them?

5. What kind of performer (p. 145) do we become in the Room of Grace? How does this change your perspective on Grace vs. "doing good deeds"?
